Adjectives

- What is an adjective?
 - Adjectives in a multilingual grammar resource
 - Adjective complement copulas too

Adjectives

- **i-kure-re** (Bororo, Crowell 1979)
 - I am tall
- tungkwaltiringa **pumpuka** (Tiwi, Osborne 1974)
 - the stringy bark is good
- wə-níh-l-ək-on **màt**-ahsəm (Penobscot, Quinn 2006)
 - the bad dog kills him

Adjectives

- So: What is an adjective?
- Define semantically
 - [syntactically, morphologically, or semantically distinct] word with prototypical adjectival meaning
- Leave it up to the grammarian

Adjectives

- Syntax of adjectives: two primary constructions
 - Attributive: the **big** dog barks
 - Predicative: the dog is **big**

Adjectives

- Attributive variations
 - word order
 - agreement

Adjectives

- Agreement in only one construction
 - der gro~~ße~~ Hund bellt [deu]
 - der Hund ist groß [deu]
- Planned construction-specific agreement solution
 - Lexical rule divergence in morphotactics for inflected vs uninflected

Adjectives

- Predicatives
 - Copula complement
 - Stative predicate
 - Mixed

Adjectives

- Copula complement
 - about half the world's languages (Stassen 2013)
 - Most common in Indo-European
 - the dog **is** big

Adjectives

- Stative Predicate
 - just under half the world's languages (Stassen 2013)
 - adjective directly combines with subject
 - **i-kure-re** (Bororo Crowell 1979)
1.SG-tall-NEUTRAL
'I am tall' [bor]
 - Includes “zero copula” phenomena (such as Russian)
on **molodoj**
1.SG.MASC.NOM young
'I am young' [rus]

Adjectives

- Mixed
 - Split
 - Different adjectives behave different
 - Switching
 - One adjective behaves in multiple ways
 - different inflection, copula complement, etc.

Adjectives

- Split
 - Rama (Colette Grinevald, from Stassen 2013)
 - nsut tiiskibadut s-angaling-i
1.PL children 1.PL-hungry-PRES
'We children are hungry' [rma]
 - ning suurak mliima
this pineapple good
'This pineapple is good' [rma]

Adjectives

- Switching
 - Maori (Biggs 1969)
 - ka pai te whare nei
INCEP good DET.DEF house this
'This house is good' [mri]
 - he pai te koorero
INDEF good DET.DEF talk
'This talk is good' [mri]

Adjectives

- Switching
 - two phenomena
 - optional inflection / multiple inflection paths
 - optionally copula complement
 - Both phenomena: divergent lexical rules

Adjectives

- Incorporation (Baker 1988)
 - Penobscot (Quinn 2006)
 - *mkʷɪhtəkʷe*
məhkʷ-əhtəkʷ-e-w
red-river.LV^{N1}-W
'it is a red river' [aaq-pen]
 - REL added through lexical rule

Copulas


- Complement type
 - Some languages have different copulas for different complement types
 - Constrain to APs for now
 - Copula inflection

Analysis

- Process: compare ERG (and other grammars), existing grammar matrix definitions to typology: fix as necessary


Analysis

- ERG adjective type hierarchy



Analysis

- ERG adjective type (simplified)




Analysis

- Construction availability
 - Attributive only: PRD -
 - Predicative only: PRD +
 - Both: underspecified
- Modification direction: POSTHD

Analysis

- Precedents
 - Current Grammar Matrix Adjectives



Analysis


- Problems with the ERG
 - Doesn't do stative predicates, agreement, etc.

Analysis

- Problems with the Grammar Matrix
 - Doesn't handle predicative or attributive only adjectives

Analysis

- Simplify the ERG?




Analysis

- Issues:
 - Attributive only has non-empty XARG value
 - How to constrain for stative predicate?
 - Is attributive only really a special case of regular adjectives?
 - Is predicative only really not associated with regular adjectives?
 - Split these apart

Analysis

- Split the ERG?



Analysis


- PRD +/- for copula... how to constrain for stative predicates?
 - SUBJ < > to keep attributive only out of stative predicate
 - PRD – to keep attributive only out of copula complement

Analysis

- How to keep predicative only stative predicate adjectives out of attributive construction?
 - MOD < >

Analysis

- MOD < > + SUBJ < >



Status

- ~75% working
- Still need to implement divergent inflection paths for:
 - optional copula complement
 - divergent morphological paths
 - agreement in only one construction
