Open Multi-Lingual Wordnet

- Collaborative InterLingual Index (CILI)
 - Share new synsets between languages
 - ▶ July 15th roll out
- More lexical types
 - Exclamatives (hi, tally ho!, checkmate)
 - Pronouns (even more)
 - Classifiers
 - Chengyu
- More languages
 - Romanian, Open Dutch, Ita-, Slovakian, Lithuanian and Icelandic Wordnets (Ancient Greek, Gaelic, Abui queued)
 - Linked Swadesh Lists (1,200+ languages)
 - ★ Matrix starter vocab anyone?
 - ★ Also made Singapore Sign Language Swadesh entries



Open Multi-Lingual Wordnet ToDo

- Tighter Integration with Corpora
- Sense annotated and parsed definitions
- Simple definitions for core vocabulary
- Linking to ontologies (updatable)
 - Geonames (with Trento)
 - Snomed (with Amanda Hicks)
 - Wiktionary (with Patricia)
- Propagate Sentiment
- Cross-lingual sense-level linking
- More on variants



NTU multilingual corpus

- Small, deeply analysed corpus
 - ▶ 6,000+ sentences x 3 languages (cmn, eng, jpn); 2,000 in Indonesian
 - ★ Mainichi Newspaper (NICT translations)
 - ★ Sherlock Holmes (DANC, SPEC, REDH[eng])
 - ★ Cathedral and the Bazaar (many languages)
 - ★ Spider's thread 「蜘蛛の糸」
 - ★ Singapore Tourist data (plus Korean, Viet, Indo)
 - ► Hand alignment, WordNet tagging, Treebanking, Sentiment, ...
- Revised the DB structure; second round of wordnet tagging
 - Slightly behind schedule
 - Wordnet extension is being done in parallel
- Tagged Italian (SPEC) ready to start Bulgarian, Dutch, German



Grammars and Tools

- ullet Chinese Grammar (Zhong $[\ |\])$ expanded
- Indonesian (INDRA) expanded
- Jacy Book in final copy-edit!
- Linguistic Type Database updated to work for all types (uncommitted)
- Even easier to use pydelphin, nice demo, MT, ...
- Just starting forestry again
- Very useful discussion in the VLAD

 - ▶ Trying to make semantics more accessible
 - Would be nice to add some inference :-)
 - Also gets a range of data from students
 - paraphrases, idioms, sense annotation, sentiment
- Inter-lingual equivalence in lexical databases; NSC (Poland)
