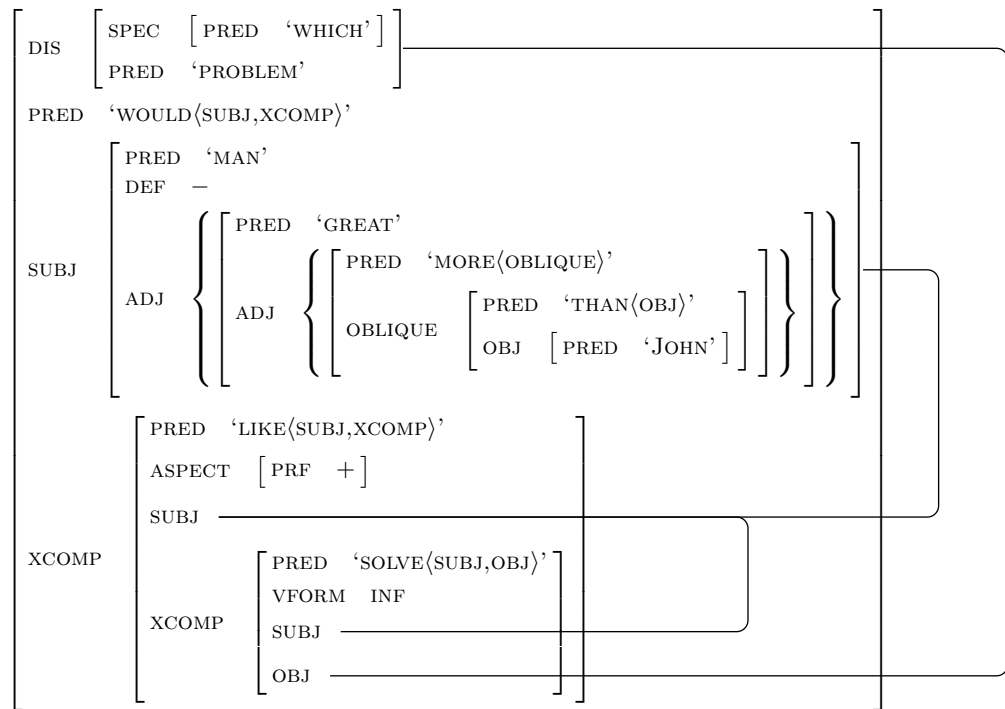
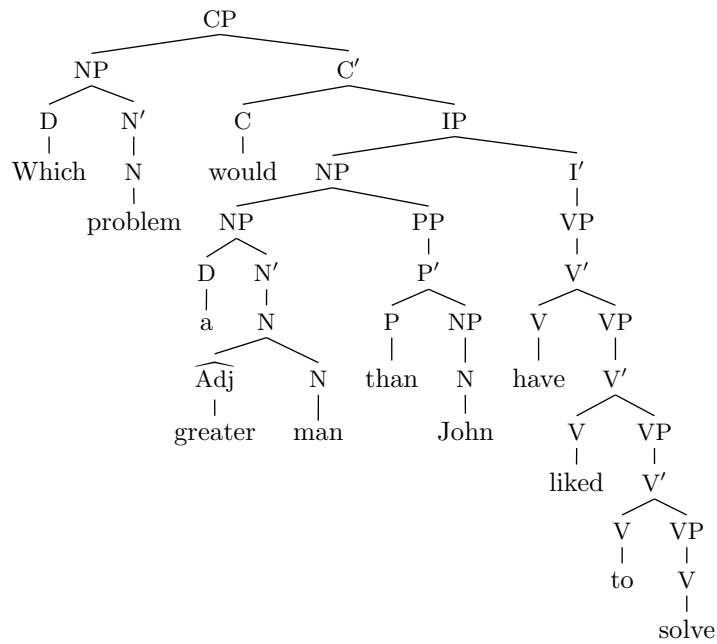


Example 5: Which problem would a greater man than John have liked to solve?



Displaced dependent constructions, Arnold & Sadler (2013):

- In general (i.e. by default), lexical items in categories that allow complements are X^0 ; \widehat{X} items do not have complements.
- English: pre-head (in particular, pre-nominal and pre-adjectival) positions are restricted to \widehat{X} s (e.g. \widehat{A} , \widehat{Adv} and \widehat{Deg}).
- English: post-head (esp. post-nominal and predicative positions) are restricted to XPs (i.e. projections of X^0).
